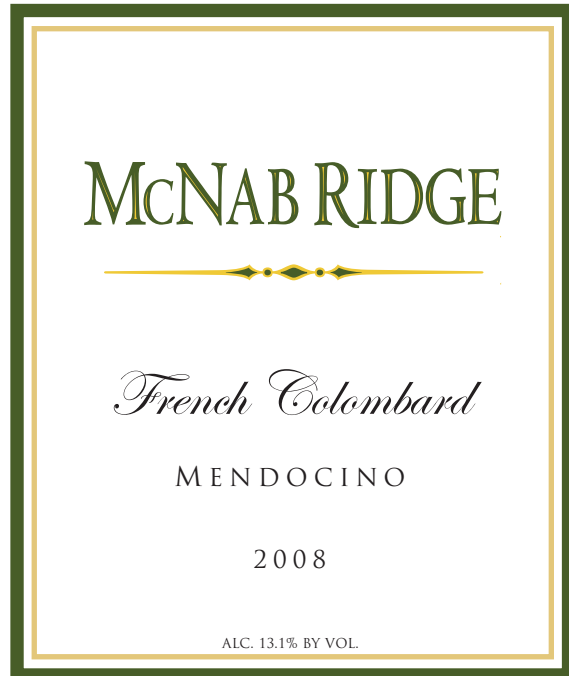

The 2008 dry farmed, head pruned French Colombard grapes are grown in Niemi Vineyard by Alvin Tollini, Bill's grandson. 100% French Colombard, it's crisp, clean and fun to drink.
