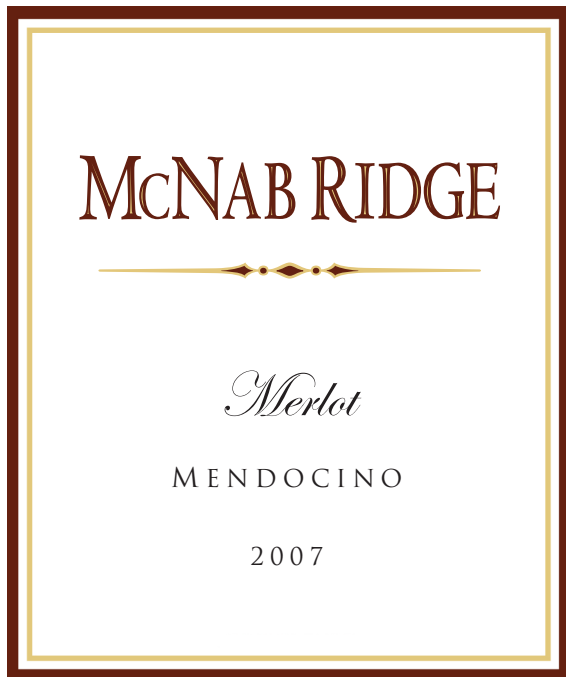


McNAB RIDGE WINERY

Winemaker Notes

McNab valley grapes create a Merlot with emphasis on fruit with aromas of blueberry and slight chocolate. Entry is mouth-filling with flavors of spice and balanced oak. Finishes with lasting fruit and mild tannins.

2007 McNab Ridge Merlot pairs well with meat dishes & robust vegetarian fare.
