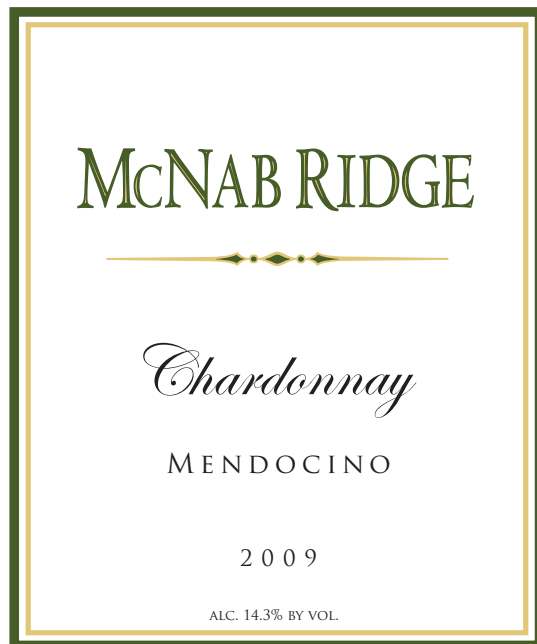


# McNAB RIDGE WINERY

## Winemaker Notes

Round and viscous on the palate followed by mouth-filling flavors of pears and apples. A touch of toasty oak frames the tropical nature of this well balanced Mendocino County Chardonnay.

Pairs well with cracked crab, fish in cream sauce, oysters or chicken dishes.
