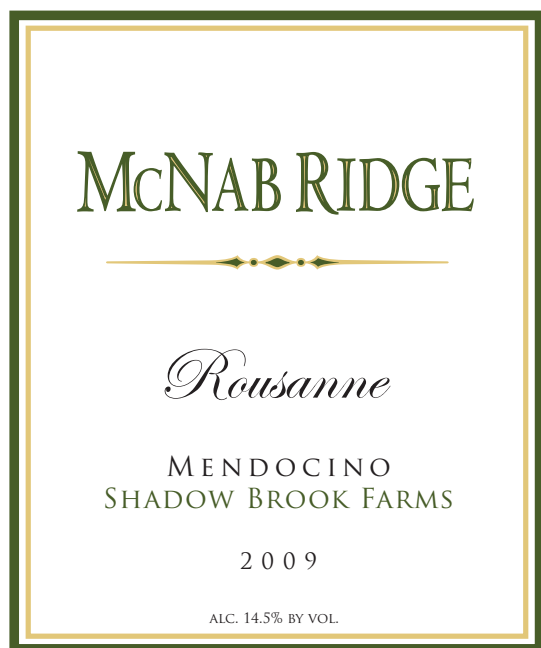

Winemaker Notes

Native to the Rhone Valley in France, Roussanne is prized for its fragrant aromas, bright acidity and rich texture. At optimum maturity, the clusters are golden in color with a reddish hue and have generous stone fruit flavors.

Fermented in 100% stainless steel, McNab Ridge's 2009 Roussanne expresses floral aromas intertwined with honey and peach. Harmonious flavors of pear, apricot and spice coat the palate and linger effortlessly to a smooth and silky finish. The lively, yet balanced acidity makes this an excellent choice to pair with food.
