Winemaker Notes:

The grapes for the 2018 vintage were chosen from the White Oak Ranch, Whaler and Largo Ridge Vineyards. These vineyards are all located in the hillsides off the eastern bank of the Russian River between Hopland and Ukiah in the area known as Largo.

The wine has a beautiful black cherry character with distinct aromas and flavors of cassis, cocoa, elegant cigar box & beautiful dark fruits. This full-bodied and balanced wine has a richly woven texture and a lingering finish that displays evolving dark berry, vanilla and baking spice flavors.

Pair with your favorite grilled steak, pan seared duck breast or a delicious Portobello Burger.
