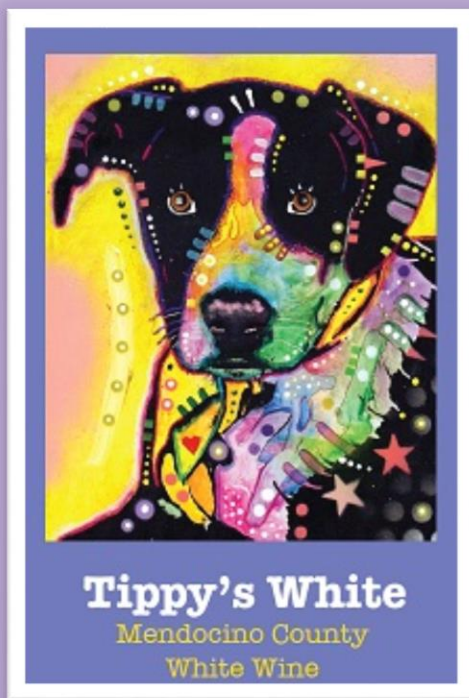


# TIPPYS WHITE
